- By rail: take S7 express train to Haslau, then passenger ferry to Orth/Donau and continue on foot
- By bus: take the "Postbus" from Kagran in Vienna's 22nd district (call +43 (0) 1 711 01)
- By taxi: share a taxi from Gross-Enzersdorf ("Sammeltaxi AST" on +43 (0) 810 810 278)
- By bicycle: take the "Donauradweg" (Danube cycling path); junction is 5 minutes

#### The Schlossinsel Wetlands Grounds

Tour the Schlossinsel grounds and discover up close the characteristic flora and fauna of the wetlands with all your senses. Observe the European ground squirrel and the Pond Turtle as well as various snake species. In and on the water, spot amphibians and see the lively dragonflies and moths. Listen for the various bird calls, and discover the rare aquatic plants, colourful wildflowers and majestic native trees which grace the grounds.



The walk-in underwater observatory makes it possible to glimpse the huge variety of aquatic life in a Danube backwater. Native fish species may press up against the glass, and a variety of mussels and other aquatic species can also be observed in their natural habitat. There are many places to sit, relax and enjoy the idyllic atmosphere. For children, the Schlossinsel features a suspension bridge, a short nature path as well as an oversized bird's nest to play in.



#### **Schlossinsel Guided Tours on Special Themes**

Once a month, tours focussing on special themes take place on the Schlossinsel. With National Park rangers as your guides, learn valuable and occasionally astonishing facts about the plant and animal kingdom of the Danube wetlands. The theme depends on the season: from bird calls in the spring to wild fruits and berries in the autumn; or how animals raise their young during the warmer months, to underwater organisms in their aquatic environment.
