Come visit us to learn more about the fascinating world of the Danube wetlands. In our hands-on “DonAuräume” exhibit, National Park rangers will accompany you through the history and creation of this unique riverine landscape and the National Park itself.

In the Baroque “Au-Theatre”, take a journey back in time and shape your own wetlands landscape. Get a bird’s eye perspective on the special things to be discovered in this region. And listen for the siren songs of the Danube mermaids, who have many fascinating stories to tell about the wetlands and the National Park.

**Guided exhibit tours & visits to the Schlossinsel**  
DonAuräume guided tours take place daily at 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., and at 1:00, 2:00, 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. The Schlossinsel and special exhibitions in the castle tower may be visited without a guide. Prior reservations are not required.

Go below the surface to spot the rare nase, a fish species which thrives in the current and among the stones. The nase is a model flagship species for our vision of a free-flowing Danube.

The schlossORTH National Park Centre and the Schlossinsel are wheelchair accessible (with the exception of the lookout point).

How to get here:

- By rail: take the S7 express train to Haslau, then passenger ferry to Orth/Donau and continue on foot
- By bus: take the “ÖBB Postbus” 391 from Vienna (Tel. +43 (0)51 717)
- By shared taxi from Gross-Enzersdorf: “Sammeltaxi AST 2 Marchfeld” (Tel. +43 (0) 810 810 278)
- By bicycle: take the “Donauradweg” (Danube cycling path); junction is 5 minutes away
- By car: take the B3 to Orth/Donau

Please keep in mind that dogs are not allowed on the Schlossinsel or in the exhibit “DonAuräume”.

The Schlossinsel Wetlands Grounds

Tour the Schlossinsel grounds and discover up close the characteristic flora and fauna of the wetlands with all your senses. Observe the European ground squirrel and the Pond Turtle as well as various snake species. In and on the water, spot amphibians and see the lively dragonflies and moths. Listen for the various bird calls, and discover the rare aquatic plants, colourful wildflowers and majestic native trees which grace the grounds.



The walk-in underwater observatory makes it possible to glimpse the huge variety of aquatic life in a Danube backwater. Native fish species may press up against the glass, and a variety of mussels and other aquatic species can also be observed in their natural habitat. There are many places to sit, relax and enjoy the idyllic atmosphere. For children, the Schlossinsel features a suspension bridge, a short nature path as well as an oversized bird’s nest to play in.

Programmes for Groups and Schoolchildren

The schlossORTH National Park Centre offers a range of interesting programmes for groups. Please contact us to learn more about group options, including guided tours of all the Schloss Orth highlights, nature walks on the Schlossinsel, and even fun nature trivia quizzes in which agility and team spirit come into play.

Kindergarten and school classes are welcome here, and encouraged to explore the environment in a playful and creative way. For example, our “Wetlands Explorers” programme gives children and youth the chance to learn more about wildlife habitats and their characteristics by observing fauna and flora up close.

## Welcome to the schlossORTH National Park Centre!

Orth Castle, or Schloss Orth, looks back on a long and rich history. Built in the 12th century as a medieval moated castle and opulently fitted out in Renaissance style in the 16th century, Orth Castle was also one of Crown Prince Rudolph's favourite hunting grounds. The castle was used for a long time for agricultural purposes until its conversion in 1957 to a museum.

After extensive refurbishment and retrofitting it was re-opened to the public in 2005 as the schlossORTH National Park Centre. Ever since, the site has been home to the National Park Visitor Centre, the museumORTH, and the Event Centre of Orth/Donau. The Marchfeld region is rich in castles, culture, history and nature. The schlossORTH National Park Centre is part of the broader Marchfeld "Schlösserreich" regional offering.
